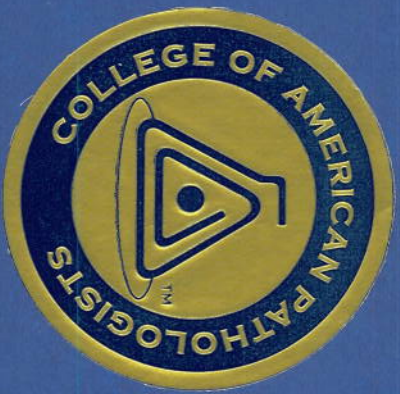

- Have a written policy and procedure for investigating complaints that is incorporated into the Laboratory Quality Management Plan;
- Provide a trained and appropriately experienced inspection team comparable in size and scope to that required for its own inspection, if requested by the regional and/or state commissioner, at least once during the two year accreditation period;
- Effectively participate annually in a CAP-accepted proficiency testing program;
- Notify the CAP Office of changes in location, ownership, or directorship of the laboratory. Accreditation does not automatically survive these changes. Documentation, including a copy of the new director's curriculum vitae and an organizational chart, will be requested for evaluation of the laboratory's accreditation status;
- Notify the CAP Office when there is a change in the laboratory's test menu, prior to beginning testing;
- Submit a completed Self-Inspection Verification Form in the interim year.

The Accreditation Committee congratulates you on the accreditation of the laboratory under your direction and the excellence of the services you are providing. Please remember CAP accreditation is not a substitute for continuous in-depth monitoring by the laboratory and its personnel to maintain a safe and properly functioning laboratory.
